Minimum Suspensions for Players Policy

Policy Number:

Commitment to Te Tiriti o Waitangi.

IHNZ recognises Te Tiriti o Waitangi as Aotearoa New Zealand's founding document. IHNZ is committed to upholding the mana of Te Tiriti o Waitangi and the principles of Partnership, Protection and Participation.

Purpose.

The purpose of the Minimum Suspensions for Players Policy is to establish clear and consistent guidelines for the imposition of suspensions following match penalties in Inline Hockey New Zealand (IHNZ) games. This policy aims to ensure that disciplinary actions are applied uniformly across all levels of play, upholding the principles of fairness and accountability.

Application.

All Match penalties shall be reviewed by a disciplinary panel. For Game Misconducts, unless otherwise noted in this policy, automatic suspensions may be issued for penalties occurring in all games where a disciplinary panel would not be practical. Alternative disciplinary measures should not be used in substitution of the minimum number of games specified in this policy.
